

<u>Department of Religious Studies – Limited Term Appointment</u>

The **Department of Religious Studies** at **St. Francis Xavier University** invites applications for a 9-month Limited Term Appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor to begin August 12, 2024.

Applicants should have a PhD in Religious Studies or Theology and show evidence of strong teaching ability. The successful candidate will teach six courses (18 credits) of undergraduate courses mainly on Hinduism and Buddhism: RELS 225: Cults and Alternative Religions; RELS 297: History and Philosophy of Yoga; RELS 315: Authentic Power and Gender; RELS 327: Buddhist Thought: The Way of the Bodhisattva RELS 326: Hindu Deities and RELS 402: Religious Approaches to Sexuality.

The Department is seeking candidates who are committed to contributing to StFX's priorities of equity, diversity, and inclusion. Demonstrated ability in fostering a climate of inclusion in the classroom is an asset.
