Department of Modern Languages – Limited Term Position in French

The **Department of Modern Languages** at **St. Francis Xavier University** invites applications for a 9-month limited term position in French for the 2024-25 academic year, beginning August 12, 2024.

St Applicants should have native or near-native fluency in French, a PhD (completed by the start of their appointment) in a field related to French or Francophone cultures, and a demonstrated record of teaching French as a second language.

The successful candidate will be expected to undertake a teaching load of six courses (three per term): four language courses, one French business course, and one course in the area of expertise of the candidate.

St. Francis Xavier University is committed to the principles of equity, diversity, and inclusion.
