Overview

StFX is a top ranking Canadian university and we are seeking a **Project Coordinator for the Academic Transitions Program (X-Act).** Reporting to the Academic Success Centre Manager, the X-Act Project Coordinator will be responsible for managing the onboarding, training, scheduling, and supervision of 20-30 student staff.

About the X-Academic Transitions Program: Learning at university draws on many of the skills students already have, but even so, it takes some time to learn how to succeed in their classes. This program will help students develop and enhance the learning skills and strategies they will need to be successful in their first year at StFX. Topics include time management, using a syllabus, using Moodle, academic integrity, academic regulations, studying, coping with stress, and how to connect with campus resources.

The six-week program developed by the Academic Success Centre and is delivered by Education students. Registration is open to any first-year student at StFX, including incoming transfer students.
