The Spatializing Care Lab in the Department of Sociology at St. Francis Xavier University requires two contractual part-time Research Assistant (RA) positions for the period of May 2 and July 29, 2022, for 10-15 hours a week. The RAs will support qualitative research and knowledge mobilization activities related to Lab-led or affiliated projects on equity in aging, accessibility, and care - including and *The Art of Good Care, Health Equity in Dementia Care, Learning and Leading with Lived Experiences, Safe Spaces for Aging and Care.*

DUTIES: The Research Assistant (RA) responsibilities will include coding and analysis of qualitative interview data, reporting and manuscript development, and assistance with coordination and contributions to posters, presentations, webinars, and community engagement events. Training and mentorship will be provided. Ideally the work will be conducted at the Spatializing Care Lab. Some work may be conducted remotely; in which case the applicant must have access to a computer and Internet.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of a bachelor's degree - preferably in social sciences, health or related fields. Students entering their final year of study are also encouraged to apply.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Excellent planning, organizational, prioritization, and time management skills and high regard for quality and attention to detail.
- Proficiency in software applications (i.e., Microsoft Office, Excel) is required.
