StFX Online Withdrawal & Refund Policy

A student withdrawing from a course should immediately notify the Program Office in writing (e-mail). Notification to the instructor does not constitute official withdrawal from a course and not considered in the calculation of refund – you must follow the steps indicated below.

Refunds are based on the date the formal notice of withdrawal is received by the Program Office.

Undergraduate Online Courses

• Fall/Winter terms:

- To drop a course, log onto the StFX Home Page (<u>www.stfx.ca</u>), click on MyStFX, and then click Students - MyData, & Banner Self Service via Portal. Click on Banner / mesAMIS, enter email and password info, click on Banner Self Service and enter Student ID and PIN. Follow instructions from there. Spring & Summer terms:

- If a student withdraws from an undergraduate course during the spring or summer terms: immediately notify Centre for Online Learning and Professional Studies by e-mail: stfx.ca. Include your StFX ID# and the course name/number in the e-mail subject line.
- If a student withdraws up to and including the day the online course begins, a full refund is issued. If a student withdraws in the first week, 2/3 of the tuition will be refunded; 1/3 if withdrawal is in the second week. During or after the third week, no refunds issued.

<u>Distance Nursing (Post RN BScN Program)</u>

- If a student withdraws from a course in the Post RN BScN Program (Distance Nursing), immediately notify the Distance Nursing Program Office by e-mail: distance.nursing@stfx.ca. Include your StFX ID# and the course name/number in the e-mail subject line.
- If a student withdraws up to and including the day the online course begins, a full refund is issued. If a student withdraws in the first week, 2/3 of the tuition will be refunded; 1/3 if withdrawal is in the second week. During or after the third week, no refunds issued.

Master of Education

- Students withdrawing from a course or the MEd Program should immediately notify the MEd Program Office by email: med@stfx.ca. Include your StFX ID# and the course name/number in the subject line.
- Prorated refunds are made from the date of the notice of withdrawal. No refund is available after nine (9) class hours have elapsed. A \$100 administration fee is charged if a student withdraws from a course within two weeks prior to the start date of the course.
