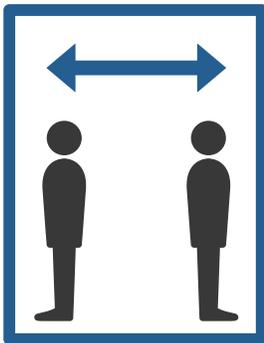

- Avoid gathering in lunch rooms, meeting rooms, and shop areas

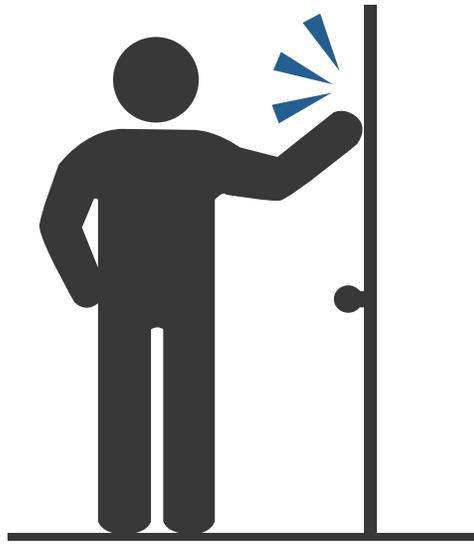

Priority access is given to persons using mobility devices.

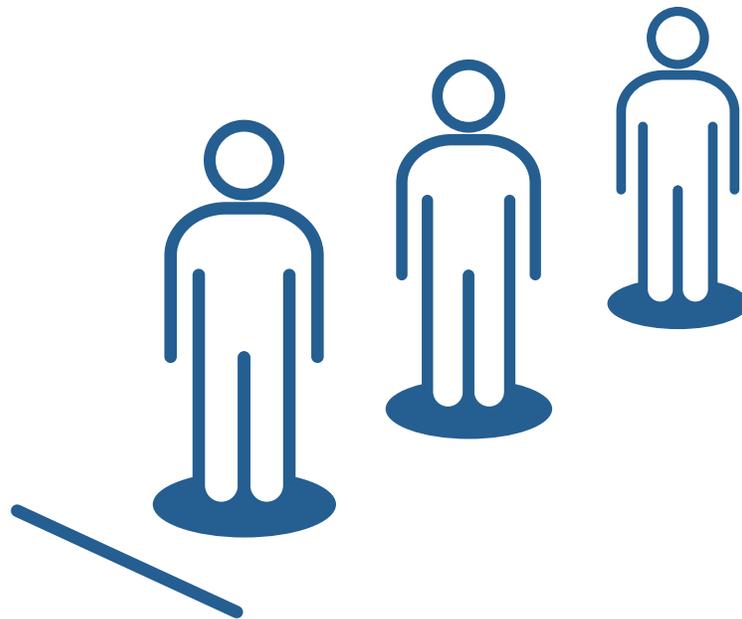

- Proceed forward when the person in front of you has been helped.

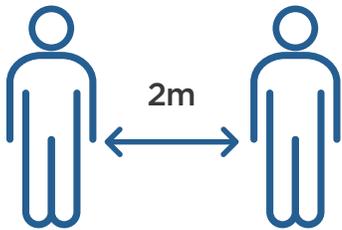

- Limit the number of items you touch.

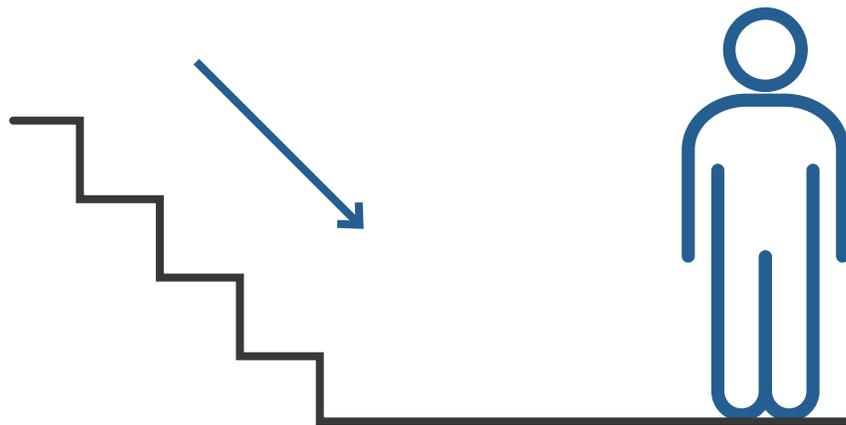

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer after touching handrails and door handles.

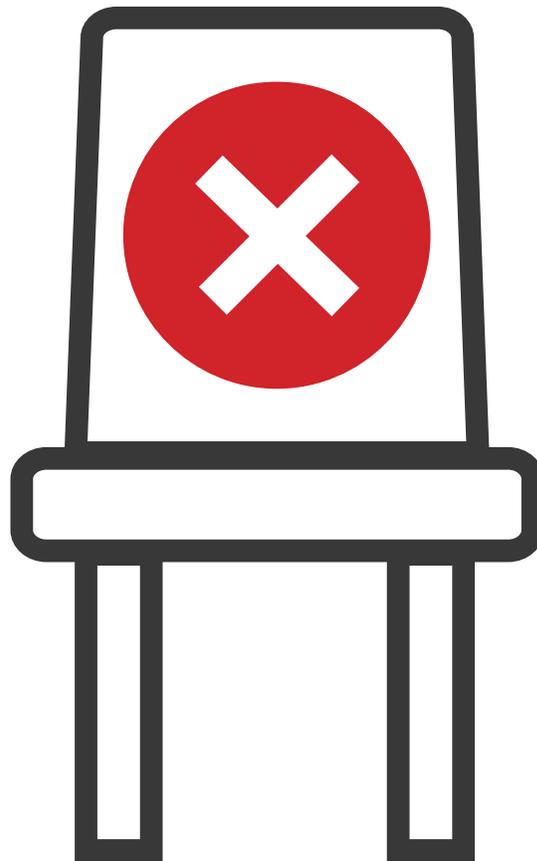

2



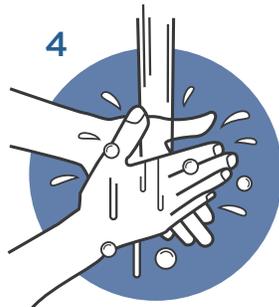
Apply soap and scrub for 15-20 seconds

6



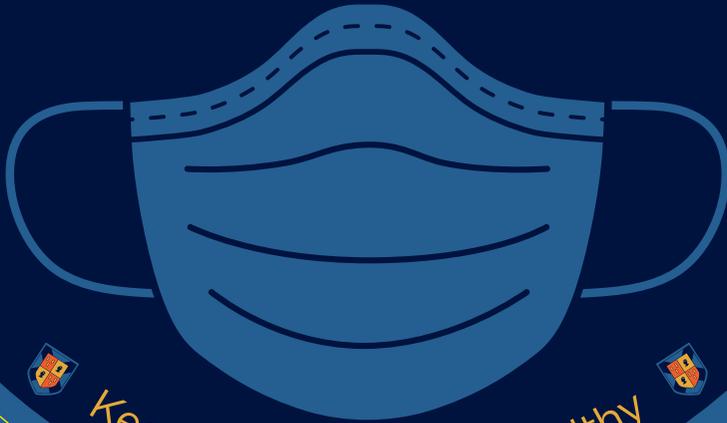
Turn off tap with a towel

Welcome back to StFX Campus! As per the Nova Scotia Government's regulations, usage of this facility requires adhering to the following guidelines.

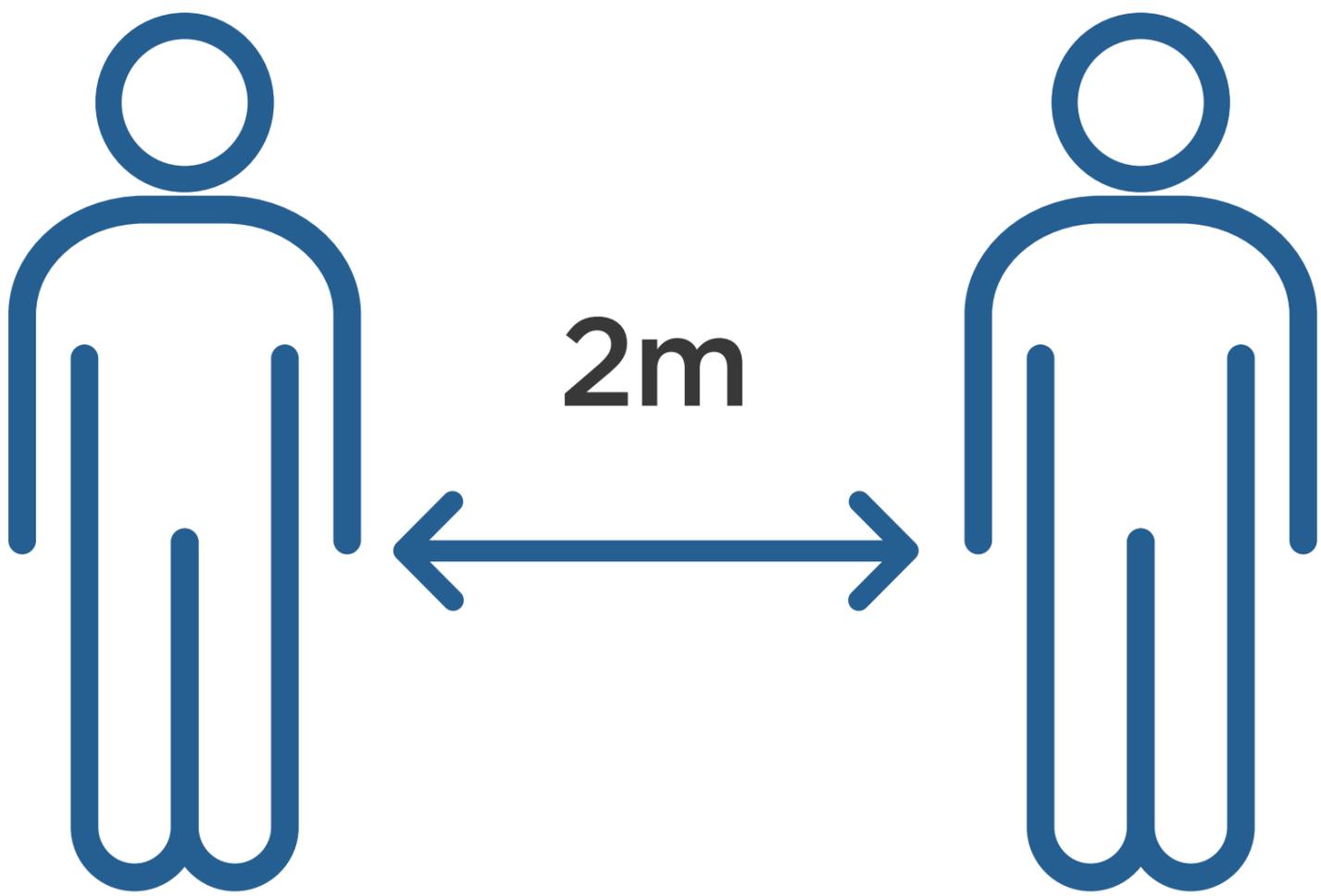
1. The turf field is currently only open for group bookings. Please go to the Keating Centre Box Office for booking inquiries.

3. The track is open to the members of the public between the hours of 8am-7pm.

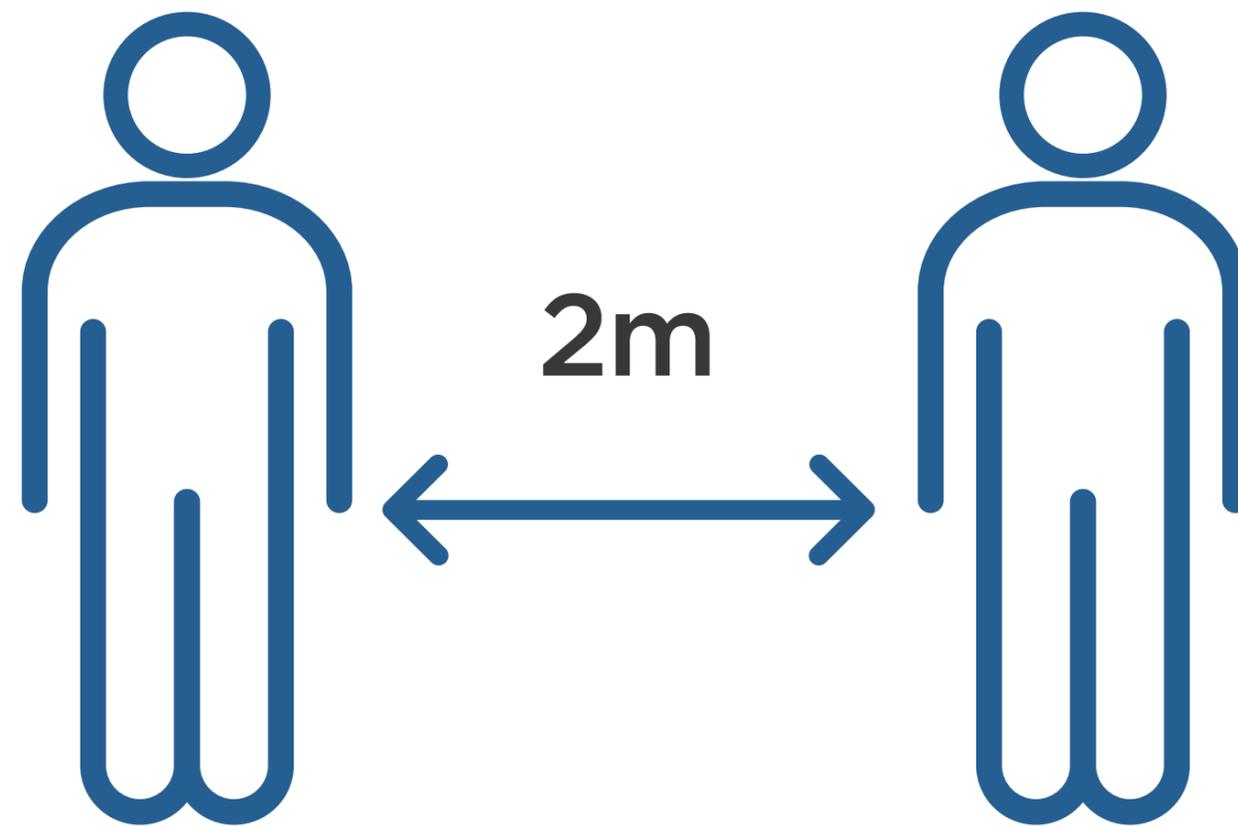
