WHAT GOES HERE?

Batteries (not including automotive/wet cell)
Employee issued mobile phones must be wiped and returned to ITS.

HOW IT WORKS?

Drop your batteries into the Cardboard Box.
Batteries that require a bag or taped terminals are 9-volt Alkaline, Lithium Ion, Lithium Primary, and Small Lead Acid batteries. (See other side for details)

| Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd) |  | Cordless power tools, cordless phones, digital cameras and video cameras, two-way radios, biomedical equipment, professional video cameras. | <p style="text-align: center;">X NO</p> |
| Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH) |  | Cellphones, cordless power tools, digital cameras, two-way radios. | <p style="text-align: center;">X NO</p> |
| Nickel Zinc (Ni-ZN) |  | Digital cameras, wireless keyboards, small electronics. | <p style="text-align: center;">X NO</p> |
| Alkaline/Single-Use |  | Alarm clocks, calculators, flashlights, TV remote controls, remote control toys. | <p style="text-align: center;"> ✔ 9V battery (YES) (rectangular battery in picture) ✘ All other alkaline/single-use batteries (NO) </p> |
| Lithium Ion (Li-Ion) |  | Cellphones, cordless power tools, cordless phones, digital cameras, two-way radios, laptop computers, tablets and e-readers. | <p style="text-align: center;">✔ YES</p> |
| Small Sealed Lead Acid (SSLA/Pb) |  | Mobility scooters, fire emergency devices, UPS systems, hospital equipment, emergency lighting. | <p style="text-align: center;">✔ YES</p> |
| Lithium Primary |  | Car keyless entry remotes, watches, pacemakers, hearing aids, memory backup, fire alarm devices, military electronics. | <p style="text-align: center;">✔ YES</p> |
