

Linking Videos within Moodle

Summary


- “Turn editing on”
- “Add an activity or resource”; Add “URL”
- Copy and paste video URL into box and enter Name for resource
- “Save and return to course”

Instructions

1. Go to your Moodle course page. Turn Editing On.
2. Scroll to the topic or section you wish to add the video link. At the bottom right of every topic there is the “Add an Activity or Resource” option. Please select this.



3. A window will pop up with a list of activities. Scroll to the bottom of the list to find **resources**, including URL. Select URL and Press the Add button.



4. This opens an information page for the URL you are adding. Add the name (title) for the link. Copy the link from the webpage you will be using. (YouTube, TED, MS Stream, and other sites have “Share” options to copy their URL.) Paste the link in the “External URL” box. Then click on “Save and return to course”.

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
