The **Department of Celtic Studies** at **St. Francis Xavier University** invites applications for a nine-month, Limited Term Appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor. The position will commence on 1 September 2023. The successful candidate should have a PhD (or be near completion) in Celtic Studies or closely related field. Candidates are expected to teach three courses for each of two semesters including Gaelic Folklore of Ireland (CELT 351), Gaelic Folklore of Scotland & Nova Scotia (CELT 352), and Celtic Music (CELT/MUSI 319). The other three courses are to be determined in conjunction with the Chair of the department. Options include medieval or modern Gaelic language, Gaelic Poetry (in translation), Celtic Art, Celtic Christianity, Medieval Manuscripts, and Medieval Medicine. This position is subject to budgetary approval.
