The **Department of Music** at **St. Francis Xavier University** invites applications for a 9-month limited term position in its Piano studio for the 2023-24 academic year at the rank of an Assistant Professor.

Applicants must have professional experience in Jazz/Studio piano performance, piano teaching, classroom teaching, and ensemble leadership. The successful candidate will be responsible for 18 credit hours of teaching at the undergraduate level. The ability to work in a master class or ensemble environment is required. The successful candidate will also be required to perform as part of the Visiting Artist program and/or with faculty. Skill sets in Music Technology and/or Music Business would be beneficial to the application.

A Doctoral degree is desirable, but not required. A Master's degree along with a nationally noted performance career and significant teaching experience in higher education is required.
