

Bachelor of Education Program


- Two year program
- Options include:
 - □ Secondary Education
 - □ Elementary Education
 - □ Middle Years Option
- 11 weeks of field experience in each year of the program

Elementary Requirements

- Undergraduate Degree
- 9 credit hours in Social Studies
- 6 credit hours in English (or French if the degree is in French)
- 6 credit hours in Science





Elementary Requirements (continued)

- 6 credit hours in Math including 3 of math fundamentals
- 3 credit hours in Developmental Psychology
- Cognate coursework may be permitted





Secondary Requirements

- Undergraduate degree
- A minimum of 30 credit hours in a subject field taught in Nova Scotia secondary schools
- A minimum of 18 credit hours in a second teachable subject field





Secondary Requirements

- Additional teachable subjects enhance potential for acceptance and employment
- Cognate coursework may be permitted





Family Studies Option

- The three threads in the Family Studies curriculum are Foods and Nutrition, Clothing and Textiles, and Family Dynamics.
- Students applying for a Family Studies teachable must have two of the three threads covered in their undergraduate subject concentrations.



Family Studies Course Distribution

- In a 30-credit major for Family Studies, the preferred breakdown would be 18 credits from Nutrition and 12 credits from subjects addressing the Family Dynamics thread.
- Since there are few university options which address the Clothing and Textiles thread, our practice is to offer an elective within Education to make up this deficiency



Family Dynamics Options

Courses which would satisfy the Family Dynamics requirement:

- Economics 101, 102, 241, 335, 336
- History 308, 309
- Psychology 100, 240, 260
- Sociology 100, 210, 215, 241, 290, 325, 364











More StFX graduates are employed in contract positions following graduation






Fewer StFX graduates leave the teaching profession following graduation






More StFX graduates would make the same choice of program if they were to do it again






More StFX students rate their teaching experiences as excellent.
