Introduction

This handout is intended to teach you how to find full text Journals at the Angus L. Macdonald Library.

Step 1:

- Review the list of articles your professor has provided.
- Highlight the name of each Journal.
- In this example, the name of the journal is: **“Social Theory & Health”**

Step 2:

- Go to the Library website: library.stfx.ca
- From the “Books and More” search box, enter the name of the journal, and select the search button.
TIP: Putting quotation marks around your search term will provide more precise results






