The library will rely on you to be well-versed in social media platforms (including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and TikTok) and to offer new and innovative ideas for social media campaigns.

Working approximately five hours a week, you will work closely with our Diversity, Outreach, and Engagement Librarian and the University Librarian's office to seek ways to enhance student engagement and promote library services. The best candidates will have creative ideas, good communication skills, and a reasonable degree of technical acumen.
