

# **StFX Scholarship Applications**

# Step-by-step guide

**Important Information:** This guide will help users navigate the StFX Scholarship application process. All scholarships are applied to via online application forms. In-progress responses are recorded every time a user moves to a new page, so applicants can revisit their application over multiple sessions. Please note that you must use the same device and web browser during each session in order for your previous responses to populate.

Application-based scholarships offered by StFX can be summarized in the following three categories:

- Major Scholarship Eligibility: All incoming direct-from-high school students who will be beginning fulltime studies towards a first undergraduate degree at StFX as part of the September 2026 intake are eligible to submit a Major Scholarship Application. The deadline to submit your application and supporting materials is March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Late applications will not be considered for StFX scholarships.
- Transfer Scholarship Eligibility: All incoming undergraduate students enrolled in full-time studies at another post-secondary institution planning to attend StFX as part of the September 2026 intake are eligible to submit a Transfer Scholarship Application. The deadline for submitting your application and supporting materials is May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Late applications are not considered for StFX scholarships.
- **Separate Scholarship Eligibility**: These are application-based scholarships which sit outside the standard Major Scholarship Application. Criteria for eligibility and deadlines for submission will vary depending on the award in question.

## Before applying for a StFX Scholarship:

Open and read the application in full. Some applications may require uploaded documents.
Reach out to two (2) individuals and confirm if they are willing to act as a reference for your
scholarship application. References could be a current or former employer, teacher, high school
counselor, coach, neighbor or family friend. Family members/direct relatives should not be used

## After applying for a StFX Scholarship:

Reach out to your two references and confirm they received an email with a link to the Scholarship
Reference Form when you submitted your application. If no email can be found, advise them to check
their Junk/Spam folder.
Ensure that your StFX Admissions application is submitted prior to the March 1st deadline. Note that it
is not required to have an admissions decision by March 1st, but your application must be on file. The
StFX Admissions application form can be found <u>here</u> .
For high school students, ensure that the StFX Admissions Office has your first-semester Grade 12
transcript on file by March 1 <sup>st</sup>
For current undergraduate students, ensure that the StFX Admissions Office has your final transcript on
file by May 30 <sup>th</sup> .

#### **Reference Forms**

When completing a Major scholarship, applicants will be required to provide two (2) references who can speak to the applicants' positive qualities. You will be asked to provide a full name, email address, and contact phone number for both references.

Reference forms will be automatically sent to the email addresses you provide on your scholarship application once you hit "Submit". For your reference to complete the form, they will need your **full name, StFX Student ID number, and email address.** Once a reference form has been completed and submitted, the applicant will receive an automatic email informing them that a reference form has been submitted to support their application and who completed the reference.

An application will not be considered complete until two (2) StFX Major scholarship reference forms have been submitted. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that their references are complete by **March 1**, **2026.** 

## **Nomination-Based Scholarships**

StFX offers two scholarships annually which, in addition to the standard Major Scholarship application, require that a nomination form be submitted by a school guidance counsellor on behalf of the student. Each high school can nominate only one student for each award or can nominate the same student for both awards. Students must have a minimum overall average of 90% or higher and demonstrate leadership in school and community involvement.

When submitting a nomination form, the guidance counsellor will be asked to provide the nominee's full name, email address, and StFX student ID number. Completed nomination forms must be received on or before March 1st 2026.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### What scholarships I am eligible for?

Eligibility criteria for all StFX scholarships can be found on our webpage here.

#### How is my scholarship average calculated?

 Major scholarship eligibility is based on final marks for the five Grade 12 courses used to meet admission requirements for a student's program. Please note that final Grade 11 equivalent subject marks may be used in the interim. Course requirements used for your average calculation can be found here.

#### When can I apply for scholarships?

The StFX Major Scholarship application will be available on December 1 AST. The application needs to be completed and submitted before March 1 AST.

#### Can I review the application before completing it?

- You are welcome to enter the StFX Major Scholarship application multiple times to view the questions and
  requirements before you complete your submission. Your in-progress application will save your responses
  periodically. Please note that you must use the same device and web browser as your previous session to see
  your in-progress responses.
- Students should only submit one application. If students submit more than one, the last application submitted
  will be used for review. In this scenario, your references would receive an email notification for each
  submission, so you would need to follow up with them to advise that only one reference submission is
  required.
- Students will not be able to edit their application once it has been submitted.

- Some scholarships require answers to essay questions as part of the application process. You may wish to draft these answers in a word processing document. Please note that there is a 750-word count limit.

#### When will I know if will be receiving a Scholarship?

• Applicants that have been selected for a Major Scholarship will be contacted via email with a scholarship offer. Those recipients will have a deadline of May 15<sup>th</sup> to accept or decline the scholarship. All correspondence will be communicated via email.

#### How many awards can I receive?

• Students are not eligible to hold a StFX National Entrance Scholarship and a StFX Major Scholarship unless otherwise stated in the terms. If a student qualifies for multiple awards, only the highest value award will be offered to the student.

# If I went to school outside of Canada, but hold Canadian citizenship, what scholarships am I eligible to apply to?

• A student's citizenship, not where they went to school, typically dictates eligibility. Please review the scholarship description for citizenship requirements.

### What information is required to determine financial need?

- Family income
- Number of dependents supported by the family income
- Number of dependents attending university in the upcoming year
- Student's spouse's income
- Number of student's dependents

- Student loan
- Other details

If you wish to be considered for scholarships with a financial need component, you must demonstrate need on your scholarship application.

# I have already graduated from high school but took some time off before applying to University. Am I eligible for scholarships?

 Students who have deferred their acceptance, taken a gap year or break in studies are eligible to be considered for scholarships, provided they have not attended any other post-secondary institution since graduating high school.

## How will I know you received my submission?

• You will receive a confirmation email upon submission of the scholarship application that it has been received.
