Classes begin at 8:30 am on Monday, September 11th.

University classes are scheduled from Monday to Thursday from September 11-November, and January 8-March 7. Please refer to the Calendar of Events for important dates, compulsory events, and field experience. All student attendance concerns must be brought to the Chair of the BEd program.
