- ▶ list her extra curricular activities, i.e. current volunteer, part-time employment, and past community experience, etc.**
- ▶ summarize in a few paragraphs why she is a suitable candidate for this Bursary (especially taking into account paragraph (b) of the criteria).**
- ▶ submit two letters of recommendation from persons who are personally familiar with her qualifications for acceptance.**

**HOW TO APPLY FOR THE
“SISTERS OF SAINT MARTHA
CENTENNIAL DIOCESAN BURSARY FOR WOMEN”**

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

Purpose

Two bursaries of \$1,000 are to be awarded annually by the Sisters of Saint Martha. The purpose of the bursary is to promote the Mission and Spirit of the Sisters of Saint Martha by supporting women in their pursuit of ongoing education in the fields of Religious or Catholic Studies.

Criteria

Each bursary will be awarded:

- a) to a female student in full time studies at St. F.X., in the fields of Religious or Catholic Studies (minor, major, advanced major, or honors), requiring financial assistance (the bursary is to be used for such expenses as tuition, books, rent, etc.)**
- b) to a female student of good academic standing who shows potential in the area of responsibility, leadership, commitment to community by way of having a desire to make a positive contribution to society. In keeping with the spirit of the Sisters of Saint Martha, this student would exemplify commitment to be about the development of persons.**

Application

- a) a student may apply for this bursary only once during her undergraduate studies; however, she may apply for this bursary again should she desire to go on for post-graduate studies in the area of Religious or Theological Studies, having already completed her studies at St. F.X.**
- b) the student must submit a written application to the committee.**
