

Interdisciplinary Health Program – Limited Term Appointment

The Interdisciplinary Health Program at St. Francis Xavier University invites applications for a 6-credit part-time appointment to begin August 12, 2024. Ideally, candidates for this position will have (or be nearing completion of) a PhD in Applied Health Science, Population Health, or related area. Candidates will be expected to teach a total of 6-credits of courses, equivalent to 1 course per term. The courses will include Fundamentals of Health I (HLTH 111), and Health in All Policies (HLTH 302). Availability to teach courses inperson is preferred.

The Bachelor of Arts and Science in Health program offers students is an interdisciplinary direct entry program. Students in the BASc in Health will take courses in a wide range of disciplines and can select to focus on Biomedical Science, Global Health or Health Equity.
