Overview

Key Responsibilities

- Perform Preventive and Corrective maintenance activities on university equipment.
- Installation of small projects and modifications
- Maintain a valid automotive driver license.
- Participate in on-call support, shared amongst a maintenance team on a rotating schedule.

Qualifications

- Applicants will have High School Graduation or equivalent and Journeyman Steamfitter & Pipefitter / Plumber certification. A secondary trade or relevant experience is preferred.
- Knowledge and experience in installation and repair of heating, cooling & process piping system including ability to work on steam distribution systems is essential.
- Knowledge and experience in the installation and repair of water distribution and sanitary drainage systems is also required.
- Must have the ability to perform semi-skilled work in areas other than those covered under his/her own certificate of qualification.
- He/she must be skilled in the use and maintenance of hand, power tools, equipment and in the reading of technical drawings and instructions. Must be able to apply formulas and conversion tables to job requirements and be computer literate.
- Must reside within 25km radius of the University.
