- 6. I will not consume alcoholic beverages or illicit drugs or take prescription drugs unless they have been prescribed for me by a medical professional.

I understand that failure to conduct myself responsibly, as stated and implied by the conditions in this code of conduct, may result in sanctions, up to and including dismissal from the StFX Music Camp.
