SAFE WORK PRACTICES

- Do not perform the procedure or operate the equipment until you have been appropriately trained and authorized to do so by your supervisor.
- Inspect required personal protective equipment (PPE) and replace if required.
- Prevent all contact with skin and eyes.
- Review safety data sheets prior to use and have available.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Install signage.
- 2. Advise Security about project.
- 3. Two-person job at all times.
- 4. Make sure flooring is clean and dry.
- 5. Set up temporary ventilation.
- 6. Turn off or cover main ventilation in the area.
- 7. Mix correct amounts of compound and resin always read instructions.
- 8. Check application instructions.
- 9. After job is complete, dispose of rollers, brushes and suits.
- 10. Wash yourself with soap and water.
- 11. Barricade area until fumes dissipate, and epoxy is dry.
