SAFE WORK PRACTICES

- Do not perform the procedure or operate the equipment until you have been appropriately trained and authorized to do so by your supervisor.
- Inspect required personal protective equipment (PPE) and replace if required.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Clean booth good housekeeping.
- 2. Check and bleed air compressor.
- 3. Check and maintain spray equipment.
- 4. Check manometer for efficient vacuum.
- 5. Turn on fans and lighting.
- 6. Perform checklist above (1 to 6).
- 7. After job completed:
 - a. Turn off fans
 - b. Close fresh air intake
 - c. Shut off compressor
 - d. Clean spray gun.
