## **Professor Emerita/Emeritus**

- 1.1 A retired or retiring member of faculty may be designated Professor Emerita/Emeritus by the President of the University on the recommendation of the Rank and Tenure Committee.
- 1.2. The purpose of this designation is to honour retired faculty members who have made an exceptional contribution to their discipline or art, or to the academic life of the University.
- 2. A candidate for this designation shall normally
  - a) hold the rank of Professor; and,
  - b) have a minimum of fifteen years of service as a faculty member, and
  - have made an exceptional contribution to their academic or professional discipline or art, or to the University, in teaching or in research or creative activity
- 3.1 The Rank and Tenure Committee shall receive the names of persons proposed for the designation by January 31 of each academic year.
- 3.2. The nomination should include the reasons for supporting the nominee and have at least five supporting signatures. The nomination should be submitted by email to <a href="mailto:avp@stfx.ca">avp@stfx.ca</a>.
- 3.3 The Committee shall select by April 10 the candidate(s) to be recommended to the President.
- 3.4 If the President denies the recommendation of the Rank and Tenure Committee, they will provide the Committee with reasons in writing.
- 4. The President may also name as Professor Emerita/Emeritus members of the academic administration who have, in their administrative capacity, provided meritorious and extended service to the University.
- 5. A candidate who has been nominated for the designation but who is not selected by the Rank and Tenure Committee may be re-nominated once.
- 6. The announcement of the designation shall be made at the Spring Convocation.
- 7. The names of those designated shall be listed for their lifetime in the *Academic Calendar* and in the appropriate Departmental roster of names of Faculty members.
