SAFE WORK PRACTICES

- Do not perform the procedure or operate the equipment until you have been appropriately trained and authorized to do so by your supervisor.
- Inspect required personal protective equipment (PPE) and replace if required.
- Do not wear loose-fitting clothing, dangling jewelry, etc.
- Keep work area clean.
- Maintain safe distances from persons in the area. Always assume air nailer is loaded.

PROCEDURE

- 1. Check recommended air pressure.
- 2. Use proper connections and air hoses.
- 3. Use proper nails or staples.
- 4. Always lubricate nailer before use.
- 5. Test for proper penetration on sample of wood.
- 6. Adjust air pressure for desired penetration.
- 7. Keep finger away from trigger when not driving fasteners.
- 8. Do not overreach. User must always have balance.
- 9. Never fire into material that is too hard.
- 10. When leaving work area, always disconnect nailer.
- 11. Clean and lubricate gun after job is complete.
