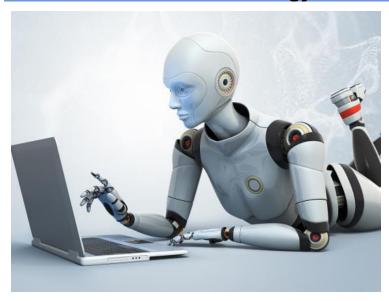


SOCI 242
