If you have a copy of your immunization record, please bring it with you. If you don't have your records, you're still welcome to attend. Public Health Nurses can review your immunization history, discuss your vaccination needs, and determine which publicly funded vaccines you may be eligible for.

Publicly funded vaccines available at the clinic may include:

- Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis (Tdap/Td)
- Measles, Mumps & Rubella (MMR)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)
- Meningococcal vaccines (including Men-B, for those who meet specific eligibility criteria)
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Hepatitis B (for those who meet specific eligibility criteria)
- Pneumococcal vaccines

A second Public Health immunization clinic will be offered in November for students who need follow-up doses to complete a vaccine series or who wish to receive seasonal vaccines, such as the annual influenza vaccine.
