Tips from StFX Students

- Create an attractive course logo
- Use colour combinations that create a positive mood
 - Blue: Enhances productivity
 - Yellow: Attention grabbing
 - Red: Energetic
 - Orange: Uplifting
 - Green: Calming
- Try to create more visuals and use less text
- Engage students with exciting titles for your headings
- Make a video as a welcome for students and to build connections early on; share -
 - Why you are excited to teach this class?
 - your experience in teaching this class?
 - How your classes will be laid out?
 - Tips for succeeding in your class
- Encourage students to share and learn together using forums and videos
 - Students ask questions and other students answer for participation points
- Take advantage of the many fun (and educational) tools available online
 - Make a digital escape room using OneNote
 - Link a glossary to a crossword on Moodle
 - Reward students with Moodle badges when they complete tasks and succeed
